Red Sea Afar Democratic organization (**RSADO**) and **ENSF** (Eritrean National Salvation Front) have had successful second joint operations in side Eritrea's elite military strong hold.

The first operation took place in side 100 Km from Asmara, capital of Eritrea, as the dawn of New Year was approaching, On Sorona, southern region, also known as(**mashalakhran**), 39th Task force(Kifle-serawit) came under fire by our brave soldiers ,killing 12 military personals , 18 wounded . In addition to that we destroyed the camp having had it under control for hours and taking caches of ammunitions.

The second simultaneous hit came from southern side of ZALMBESA inside the area known as KOKHOBAY on 13th task force(kifle-serawit) heavily armed 2nd Brigade , 1st and 2nd Battalion ,killing 13 elite soldiers and wounding over 20 seriously . We have set alight entire two camps (**aglae, Gunaguna**) upon retrieving from operation causing a major loss to the enemy, said " Ali (Katar) Hammadu daawuud (Renown freedom fighter), acknowledging the ultimate sacrificed paid by afar Martyrs in this operation ,we will continue to sacrifice at any cost to the self determination of afar Dankalya ,we will also collaborate with any opposition groups that will bring about the end to horrendous suffering by Afewrki Regime and rule of law to prevail .

The recent attack came as the regime has very limited shelf-life ,with military moral of the regime is at lowest ever, two days ago 30 marine force escaped to Yemen, terrified civilians ,athletes are seeking refuge in neighboring countries risking their lives ,As international and regional pressures on the regime are mounting , UNSC slapped sanction on Eritrean regime for destabilizing Somalia and the entire region , the sanction includes an arms embargo , as well as travel bans and asset freezes for government and military leaders aiding Somali insurgents, The regime is known as worst violator human rights and State sponsor and exporter of terrorism .

The Chairman of RSADO, Mr. Ibarhin Harun said " the momentum is in our side now, with all the those involved to see democracy prevail and even the hard core Diaspora supports for the regime is out of steam , As Afar we long realized that Afewerki was a cancer that needed to be contained , naturalized and get rid of before spreads any further". Adding the afar group will be at the fore front of the struggle for its self determination up to cessation.
